Ottawa's Tech Economy at a Glance

Ottawa is one of North America's most established tech markets, with more than 1,800 tech companies ([FedDev Ontario](#)) and the highest concentration of tech talent in North America ([CBRE, 2025](#)).

The ecosystem spans startups, scaleups, multinationals, and government-adjacent tech teams working across software, cybersecurity, telecommunications, AI, defence, and cleantech ([Invest Ottawa](#)). Ottawa also serves as Canada's R&D hub for defence innovation, anchored by D.I Hub ([Invest Ottawa](#)), and is a global leader in communications technology research ([Why Ottawa](#)).



Key innovation hubs include [Kanata North](#) (Canada's largest tech park), Downtown Ottawa, Bayview Yards, and Area X.O, supported by strong post-secondary and research institutions across the region.

- **Early-career professionals** access junior roles, co-ops, and internships through employers that actively invest in new talent.

- Digital communities that support networking before and after arrival



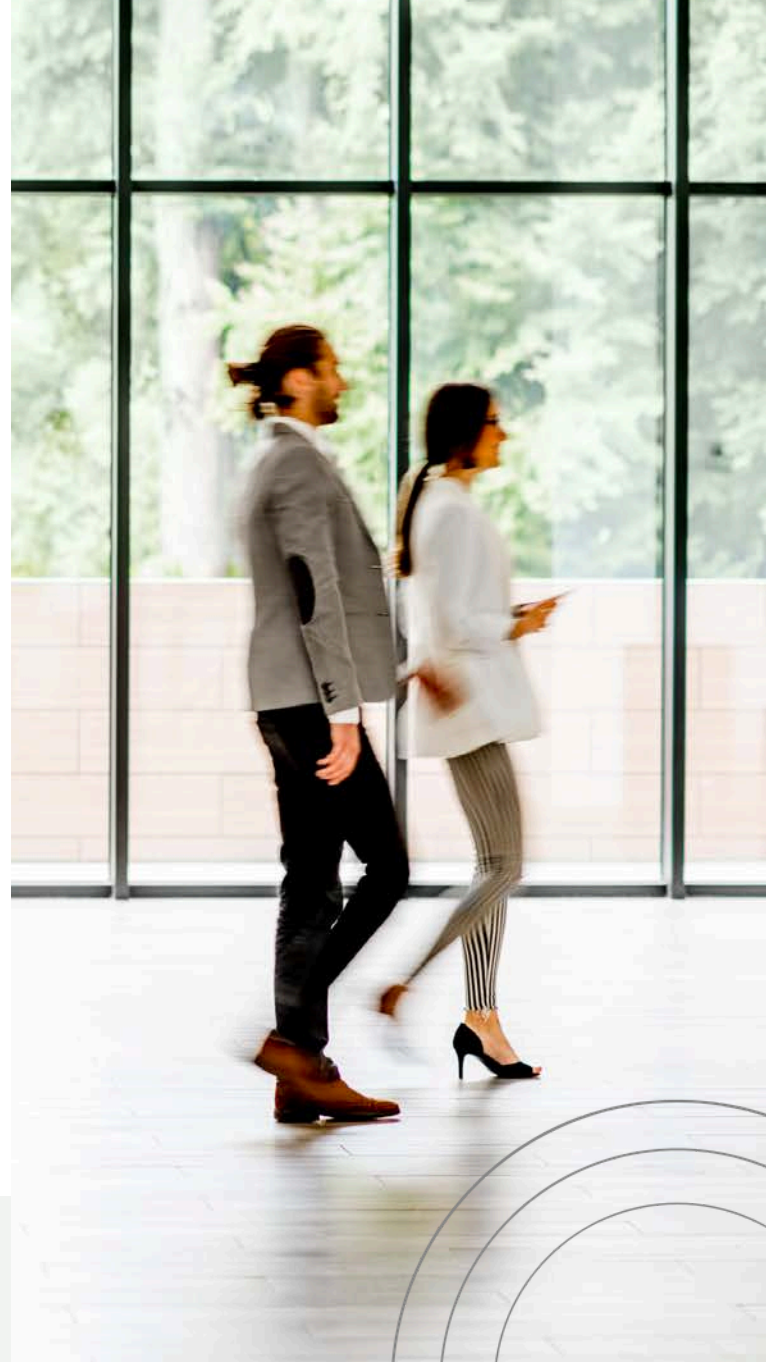
